

Norbit and GBT Offshore were in Malta a few days before to take care of the Multibeam shipping, custom documents and vessel mobilization.











Installation of the Multibeam was very easy and fast thanks to the small dimensions and portability of the Norbit system.








Interfacing Hypack and Norbit












Laser result









